

MEMBER AT LARGE:

Represent the three regions of the state: North, Central, and South. They are elected at the annual meeting and will serve a two-year term. As elected members of the Board of Directors, members at large are expected to vote. Their main purpose is to serve the members of AMTNJ in the region and to assist in encouraging non-members to join AMTNJ.

Ongoing duties:

- 1) As a representative of the general membership of a region, the MAL is expected to attend all meetings, actively participate, and vote on all business at the meeting.
- 2) Encourage teachers in your region to become AMTNJ members and to join the AMTNJ volunteer registry. Work with the administrative assistant and the volunteer registry chair to make sure that volunteers are on the list. Use the volunteer registry to obtain volunteers to serve at regional events.
- 3) Encourage members in your region to submit articles for the Journal.
- 4) As a team, meet with the other members at large for your region to brainstorm and plan math events (e.g.; mini-conferences, membership drives, etc.) to meet the needs of your region.
- 5) Consider chairing a committee for the Two-Day Annual Conference.
- 6) Write and submit articles for newsletter about your region.
- 7) Assist with any Outreach programs happening in your region.
