
Rutgers University has contributed five AMTNJ Presidents during the first sixty years of AMTNJ. The first president of AMTNJ was Richard Morris in 1914-15 followed by Emory P. Starke #17 1930-31, Albert E. Meder #22 1935-36, Robert M. Walter #35 1948-49 and F. Eugene Clark #56 1969-70.
