The Association of Mathematics Teachers of New Jersey was organized on May 23, 1914 led by Harrison E. Webb from Central High School in Newark.

Approximately 50 mathematics educators, men and women, representing public high schools and elementary schools, private schools, teachers' colleges and other colleges within New Jersey were present at the organizational meeting.



The old Central High School building (circa 1914) on High Street in Newark (now known as Martin Luther King Blvd) is now part of the campus of the New Jersey Institute of Technology (NJIT).
