Term of Office and AMTNJ Business Years

Beginning in May 1914, each President served a one year term with two exceptions. The AMTNJ business year was from spring meeting to spring meeting. After the organizational meeting was held at Central High School in Newark, Richard Morris #1 1914 – 1915 became the first President with the first regular fall meeting hosted by Rutgers in New Brunswick.

In 1985, the AMTNJ business year was changed to a fall meeting to a fall meeting. Thomas Tobisen #72 1985 - 1986 actually served more than twelve months during this period of change.

In 2006, the AMTNJ business year was changed to the current January 1st to December 31st time period. Alexis Kopperman #93 2006 – 2007 served more than twelve months during this change to the calendar year.
