

12th Annual AMTNJ Middle School Mathematics Contest

Contest Rules and Regulations

- ONLY students who are currently enrolled in grade 6-8 math or Algebra 1 are eligible to participate in the contest. Students who have already completed the whole year of Algebra 1 class are not eligible to participate in the contest.
- □ There is no limit on the number of students from your school who can participate in this contest. However, only your top five (5) students will constitute your "School Team".
- $\hfill\square$ Each school is allowed only one team.
- □ AMTNJ will present certificates to the top scoring students and the top three participating schools.
- □ The topics on this contest will cover from sixth grade math through Algebra I.
- □ The Registration Form with a fee of \$50.00 per school must be received by AMTNJ by Thursday, February 8, 2024. You can register <u>online</u> or by mail/fax. The application is posted on <u>http://amtnj.org/events/contests/</u>
- □ To be eligible for awards, the contest must be administered in one 60-minute working session without calculators on Thursday, February 15, 2024, and so certified by the faculty sponsor.
- □ Support materials cannot be used, and group work is not allowed during the contest.
- □ When a specific form of the answer is specified in a problem, only that form will be accepted; no other form will receive credit. Decimals should be at least three decimal places rounded or truncated. For example $2/3 \approx 0.666$ or 0.667. Fractions and irrational quantities must be in simplest form.
- □ Contest materials, **copy-ready**, will be emailed on Thursday, February 8, 2024. If not received by Thursday, February 8, 2024, PLEASE ALERT US.
- □ The school report form and the top 5 student answer sheets must be e-mailed no later than Thursday, February 22nd, 2024.
- □ Winners will be notified by email in March, 2024. All results will be posted on <u>http://amtnj.org/events/contests/</u> by March, 2024.
- □ Certificates will be sent to schools for personalization and printing.
